

SUTTON LAKES POOL RULES

Pool Hours: 9am-8pm

1. Sutton Lakes pools are for Sutton Lakes residents and their guest(s) ONLY.
2. Must check in with pool monitor, show photo ID. Proof of residency may be required by providing a copy of mail, or a copy of your deed or current lease, along with photo ID (deed/lease is only needed if the photo ID does not show a valid Sutton Lakes address).
3. Resident must stay with guest(s) while at the pool.
4. HOA Fees must be current.
5. No lifeguard on duty. Swim at your own risk.
6. Minors under 12 years of age must be accompanied by an adult 18 years of age or older.
7. Minors between the ages of 12 and 17, must be checked into the pool by a parent/guardian, upon initial use of the facilities. The parent/guardian will complete a form to be kept on file for the pool season; this form gives the minor(s) permission to use the facilities without the parent/guardian.
8. No more than 4 guests, per residence; not including those that live in the household.
9. No glass in the pool or on the pool deck.
10. No food or drinks in the pool.
11. No food on pool deck...please use picnic tables outside the pool gate.
12. Drinks must be kept in plastic, Styrofoam, or paper cups.
13. No visible alcoholic beverages.
14. Pool gate must be closed always, unless while entering or exiting the pool deck.
15. Proper swim attire is required.
16. Those in diapers, must wear proper swimming diapers.
17. No running or diving.
18. Shower before entering.
19. No smoking or vaping inside the pool gates.
20. Please dispose of all trash.
21. No profanity or offensive behavior is permitted.
22. If music players are used, they must be kept at a low volume, for the enjoyment of you and your guests only.
23. No animals are allowed within the pool gates, unless proof, is provided, showing the animal is a service animal.
24. Do not swallow the water, it is recirculated.
25. Do not use the pool if you are ill with diarrhea.

Pool Monitors are on-site to ensure compliance to these rules. Non-Compliance may result in being asked to leave the premises. These pools are under video surveillance.
